ARCHIVES AND COLLECTIVE MEMORY CHALLENGES AND ISSUES IN THE PLURALISED ARCHIVAL ROLE

Australia's records continuum theory outlines a four dimensional model for recordkeeping. We have been repeatedly challenged on how well this model enables appropriate attention to the cultural and social role of archives, with the emergence of powerful tools and operating paradigms for agencies within jurisdictions, but arguably not for archival organisations themselves. This seminar explores just this dimension of recordkeeping (the fourth dimension of the records continuum model).

Join our expert panel of speakers as we explore the roles, emerging challenges and tools appropriate to archival organisations operating at cross organisational levels within the social and cultural environment.

Presentations focus on the specific challenges of the archival role, the conceptual framework of the pluralised archives, and specific issues in documentation, appraisal and access. The presentations will present the most recent archival thinking locally and internationally. A case study will enable participants to continue actively engage in exploration of the issues across the three days.
